Dr. Kennedy received her bachelor’s degree in nursing and a master’s in business administration from Widener University. She received a Ph.D. in nursing from Loyola University in Chicago. Dr. Kennedy is widely presented and published in the field of informatics, nursing, health

information technology, and terminology standards. She is a fellow in the American Academy of Nursing and received the HIMSS 2009 Nursing Informatics Award as well as the top 25 women in healthcare award for 2009. She is currently on the TIGER board and sits on the safety council for the American Association of Medical Instrumentation.

Sotera develops and markets the ViSi Mobile System, the first body-worn vital signs monitoring platform to measure all vital signs continuously with intensive care unit (ICU) level accuracy for non-ICU patients.
